Those registering late (after May 10) must raise \$30/adult or \$20/child.

Each walker must complete & sign an individual registration form either in person or online.

April 14 - May 10—Team & Individual Walker Registration Deadline

Register online at <http://explorefairbanks.com/charity-walk> and pay with a credit card. You can also register to pay with cash or check. To pay with cash or check, you must come to the bib pickup and pay. If you register with a credit card, you also must come to the bib pickup. Bib pickup is on Monday, May 10 from noon to 7pm at the Morris Thompson Cultural & Visitors Center, 101 Dunkel Street, Suite 111. **Walkers registered by May 10 are eligible for prizes.**

May 11-13—Late Registration

Bring form and all money raised to the Morris Thompson Cultural and Visitor Center between 9 am and 4 pm. Late registration fee of \$5 applies. You can still designate your money to one of the already registered charities. **All Walkers who register during these days are *not* eligible for participant prizes.**

May 14 Day of Walk—Late Registration

Bring form and all money raised to the Immaculate Conception Church Parking Lot between 4 and 6 pm. Late registration fee of \$5 applies. You can still designate your money to one of the already registered charities. **All Walkers who register during this day are *not* eligible for participant prizes.**
